Cleanup continues following this morning's severe storms that moved across northeastern Wisconsin. The National Weather Service says straight-line winds with gusts of 70-80 mph were reported in Marathon County. There were no reports of injuries as a result of the storms. Local officials are conducting damage assessments. Most of the damage should be covered by private insurance.

Marathon County: Marathon County Emergency Management reports the Welcome Dairy in Colby sustained \$25,000 in roof damage from the storm. Officials say the damage is covered by private insurance. Several farm buildings in the Colby area were also damaged or destroyed.

Wisconsin Emergency Management remains engaged with the local officials. The State Emergency Operations Center currently remains at Level 4, monitoring events. While there have been no requests for state assistance, Wisconsin Emergency Management stands ready to help.
