Registration for the 2014 classes at the Regional Emergency All Climate Training (REACT) Center is now online. Registration links can be found on the REACT website <http://react.wi.gov/> under the main course headings.

The REACT Center is Wisconsin Emergency Management's (WEM) state of the art training and exercise support facility located near Camp Douglas WI, at Volk Field Combat Readiness Training Center. The REACT Center has been providing technical rescue, disaster response, and hazardous materials training to civilian agencies and the Department of Defense since 2007.

This is the first year that REACT is offering open enrollment. Now through WEM's training portal, students now have the ability to directly sign up for courses. The website will allow emergency managers, first responders, and others from across the state and nation to register for classes online and keep track of their completed courses.
